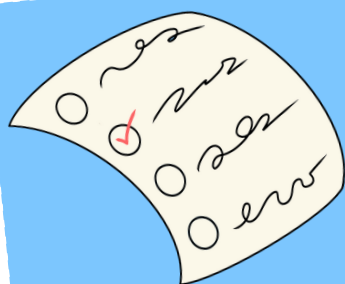
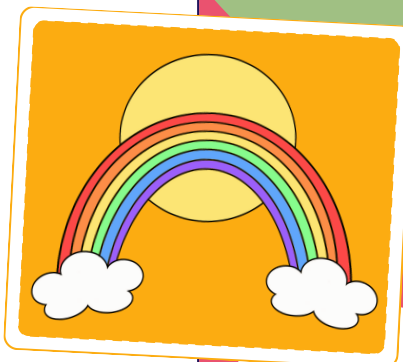
Week 1: Crazy Chaotic Cake Cooking Competition – COMEDY OF ERRORS (June 30th, July 2–4th) (\$235)

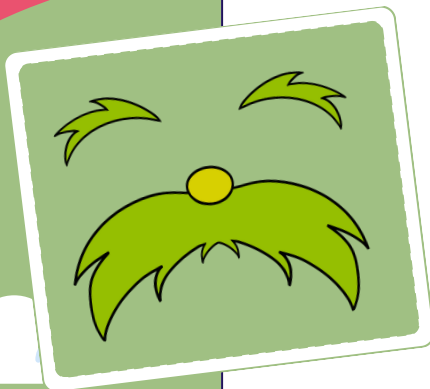
Week 3: Up for Debate: The Presidential Musical – MUSICAL (July 14–18th) (\$290)

Week 5: How Bad Can YOU Be? – MUSICAL

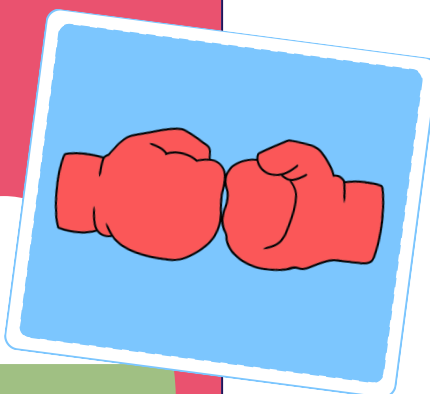
(July 28–August 1st) (\$290)

Week 7: Champion Jim The Movement– MOVEMENT

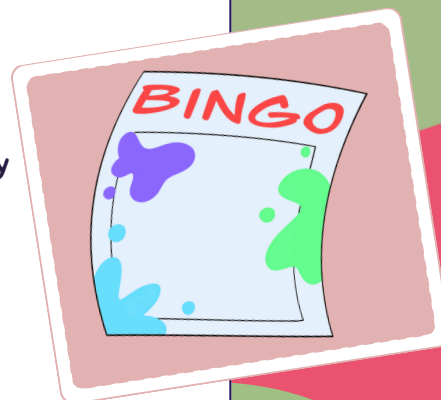
(August 11–15th) (\$290)
